Your generosity has allowed us to continue providing our teachers with free books and school supplies, and to keep the elementary school clothes closets stocked. The store will be closed for the winter season but don't fret, it will re-open on Saturday, April 5, 2025 from 10am-2pm.

YouthWorks 2024: What humbly began with one church group for two days in 2010 has quickly turned into a 14-year partnership that continues to flourish with students, their adult leaders and YouthWorks staff immersing themselves to serve God in our community by serving others with much love and enthusiasm. We are ever grateful for the help we received over the 8 weeks YouthWorks was in town this past summer. While students began painting a few of them to save the wood, several need re-glazing and many are in need of replacement. Our goal is to begin raising funds for this specific project.
